




WHAT IS OFFSIDE?

THE OFFSIDE RULE

Being offside occurs when a player is behind the line of opposing defenders when the ball has been kicked forwards to them.





CAN YOU BE OFFSIDE IF YOU HAVEN'T TOUCHED THE BALL?




MAYBE...

USUALLY NO.


UNLESS YOU'RE 'ACTIVE'.

HERE ARE TWO EXAMPLES OF 'ACTIVE' WHERE THE ATTACKER IS INTERFERING WITH PLAY.







HOW CAN THE RED PLAYER RECEIVE THE BALL AND NOT BE OFFSIDE?




SIDE OR BACKWARDS PASS FROM A TEAMMATE




CORNER YOU CANNOT BE OFFSIDE FROM A CORNER



THROW-IN You cannot be offside from a throw-in



GOAL KICK You cannot be offside from a goal kick




